NOVICE TRICKS

2-on/2-off	leave it (10 sec)
back up in a chute (5 ft)	memory game (3 baskets)
balance cookie on nose	muffin tin game
balance beam / dog walk	paws up on an object
bang game (smack a board)	pedestal (send to platform, 3 ft)
bow under a magic square	peekaboo (between my legs)
cavalettis in an arc	platform jump (2 platforms)
come	rainbow ladder (trot through)
crawl (5 crawl steps)	ring a bell to go outside
down	roll out a carpet with nose
drop it	sit
fetch (bring it near me)	speak (bark on cue)
find the hidden treats	spin circles
flying disc (in air or rolling)	stacking (for conformation)
focus (hold eye contact 6 sec.)	stay (6 ft, 10 sec)
hand signals (3 behaviors)	target disc (nose-touch disc)
hide and seek (find me)	target stick (nose-touch stick)
catch a toy in mid-air	touch my hand (nose-touch)
hoop jump	treadmill (sustained trot)
jump for joy (jump straight up)	tunnel
jump over a bar	walk on a loose leash (30 ft)
jump over my knee	wall stand (front paws on wall)
kennel up (send to crate/bed)	which hand holds the treat?
kisses	wobble board

Intermediate, Advanced, and Expert tricks can also count toward your Novice title. Below is a partial list of some of those more common tricks.

INTERMEDIATE TRICKS (PARTIAL LIST)

2-on/2-off peanut	peekaboo (while I walk)
2-on/2-off pull back on	platform jump with hoop
A-frame	pull on a rope / tug
balance on a ball or peanut	rainbow ladder (front paws only)
barrel racing (go around)	roll over
discern objects names (chose correct toy out of several)	side-step drill (magic square)
figure-8s through my legs	shake hands
flyball swimmers turn	shell game (nose at correct pail)
hand signals (6 behaviors)	sit pretty / beg
heel at left side, automatic sit	soccer (push a ball)
hold object in mouth (5 sec.)	stay (out-of-sight stay, 20 sec)
leg weave	target mark (go to a mark)
mail carrier (deliver note)	teeter-totter

ADVANCED TRICKS (PARTIAL LIST)

back up (5 ft)	pull a wagon
barrel roll (2 paws rolling it)	rainbow ladder (rear paws)
bow	say your prayers
counter (go opposite treibball)	side-step drill (fr. paws on a ball)
distance work (3 tricks, 10 ft)	skateboard (front paws only)
double hoop circle	spin circle on a small block
footsies (paws on my feet)	tap light / desk bell / easy button
head down (chin rest)	target mark (touch with rear foot)
mailbox: open lid, fetch mail	tidy up toys (into open box)
my dog can count (2+2=bark)	treibball (push ball 4 ft)
paintbrush painting (at easel)	walk another dog
play dead	wave goodbye
play the piano	wipe your paws (dig at doormat)

EXPERT TRICKS (PARTIAL LIST)

balance beam: double rails	index card cues (any method)
basketball	jump rope
cover your eyes	kennel up (open, go in, close)
disc vault/ rebound	nose work box search
find the object with my scent	rainbow ladder (step backward)
handstand against a wall	weave poles
