There is a cap on daily runs so will close when full. A waiting list will be made for those that don't make it in this time.

CONFIRMATION AND PAYMENT

Once you have submitted an entry form, you will receive an automated run confirmation email.

A trial email with any additional venue, trial information and run times will be sent 5 days before the trial.

ADD-ONS/MOVE-UPS

Same day move-ups are allowed!

Add-on runs will be available day-of if time allows for it.

No transferring of runs between dogs day-of.

Withdrawing from trial/refund policy

Withdrawals will be accepted up to 2 weeks prior the trial date. After that Refunds will only be issued for an injured dog, **in this case a vet note may be required.** Please note, all refunds are subject to a **\$20 administrative fee.**

Spectating and Social Area

We welcome and encourage spectators but please no non competing dogs.

Warm up area

Will be outdoors on grass north of the ring or in the gravel parking area.

Parking

There will be designated parking away from class building please do your best to follow signs. No parking on the grass.

Bathrooms

An outside portable toilet is available and there is a sink inside for hand washing.

Potty

ON leash walking is only allowed along the side grass strip heading down the driveway north of the Mighty building.

Designated poop buckets are available.

Please NO walking your dogs out into the field or OR around TIME4DOGS KENNEL AREA.

Crating

Please Crate in your vehicle if possible.

Course Maps

Course maps will only be released when the building opens. Paper copies will be posted in the spectating/social area and warm up area.

ENTRY TYPES

B Stream

Base stream is for dogs that have not yet earned the basic title for the level in which they are competing.

C Stream

Championship stream is for dogs who have already earned the base title for the level in which they are competing. C Stream qualifying scores are used for titles such as Bronze, Silver, Gold, Master Champion, Supreme Championship and Grand Master Champion.

C Stream qualifying scores are earned in the Advanced through Versatility Excellent levels.

Dogs must have achieved the base title for a level before being eligible to begin earning C Stream qualifying scores in that level.

Dogs may compete and earn qualifying scores in consecutive levels at the same trial if the dog completes the title in the lower level prior to the end of the trial. Should the title for the lower level not be earned, the runs completed at the higher level will be marked as invalid on the dogs record.

For Exhibition Only (FEO)

Teams may enter trials without competing for practice purposes. This is referred to as For Exhibition Only (FEO).

IS THIS YOUR FIRST CARO TRIAL?

Before you register for your first trial, you'll just need a dog ID number for CARO, which you can get super quickly here:
<https://canadianrallyo.ca/registering-a-dog/>

Then you're good to go to register once the link is released! If you don't have your Dog ID by then, no worries! Simply just write "pending" in the dog ID spot and then just email us when you receive the number. Dog ID's are a one-time payment for the lifetime of the dog. However, there is also a HUMAN membership that you can pay for yearly that gives you access too a number of perks including: a log-in that allows you to see and track all of your dogs Q's electronically AND a \$10 discount on your dog memberships! So if you are thinking you may want to become a member, I recommend filling out that form first and THEN doing your dog registration after, so that you get the discount! <https://canadianrallyo.ca/member-info/>

Equipment Reminder

A flat buckle, snap collar or a fixed harness and a leash are the ONLY approved equipment.

- Leashes - should be long enough to provide adequate slack. Hands free leashes are acceptable.
- When a fixed harness is used, the leash must be attached to the back.

Our facility promotes kind and fair treatment of animals and humans alike. The following behaviour will NOT be tolerated: Harsh or over the top verbal scolding of dogs for the purpose of punishment, physical corrections of any kind, use of aversive devices on site including e-collars or vibration collars, prong or pinch collars. Please note, CARO also restricts the use of slip leads on show grounds. Any event attendees doing so will be dismissed immediately without refund.

- Appropriate and safe use of no-pull harnesses and head halti's IS permitted so long as it is used in a way that is safe and respectful to the animal.

Exhibitors' responsibilities

- **Dogs are to be ON-LEASH and UNDER CONTROL** at all times unless in the ring.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without the benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

CARO Trial Etiquette

Like every other sport, Rally Obedience comes with its own etiquette practices which facilitate a friendly and respectful trial atmosphere. Below are some recommendations that will help new competitors prepare for attending in-person trials. In addition to the items listed below, be sure to read through all information from the trial host for anything that is specific to their event.

In general

- Remember that trials cannot happen without volunteers. Please consider taking a turn to help.
- Be kind and courteous to all.
- Be sure to check in when you arrive so that the ring stewards know that you are there.

On the trial grounds

- Always keep a distance between dogs.
- Ask before touching another person's dog.
- Pick up after your dog and leave your crating area tidy at the end of the trial.
- Share warm up space and prioritize use by those next in
- Let those who are at the top of the running order start first. They may need to leave the ring early to warm up their dogs.

Before you leave

Be sure to thank your trial host, judges, and volunteers!

Recordings

Be sure that permission is obtained before recording anyone.
